DETECT STUDY

Stanford Medicine is currently enrolling participants for an NIH-sponsored research study of a test to distinguish between type 2 diabetes and diabetes due to pancreatic cancer or chronic pancreatitis.

YOU MAY QUALIFY IF:

- You are 30 to 85 years old.
- You have Pancreatic Ductal Adenocarcinoma (PDAC) or Chronic Pancreatitis.

People with or without diabetes are welcome to participate.

STUDY PARTICIPANTS:

- Complete a **questionnaire** about your health and medical history
- Complete a **mixed-meal test** where you consume a nutrient drink and provide blood samples.
- This one-time study visit is anticipated to take **30 minutes**.
- Provide a **health status update** 12 months later.
- Participants will be compensated for their time.
